

Registration/home visits will be combined for this year.

- Registration will be on August 12th, as planned on the calendar, but we will run it a little differently.
 - District wide, the teacher/advisor will contact their students and set a time to meet with the parents/students for introductions and reconnections.
 - Advisors will call parents to set up a time to visit school for a one on one meeting on Aug 12th-much like Parent/Teacher Conferences.
 - These will be staggered every 30 minutes.
